Jewel-Osco Residency Program Overview

- Each resident of the Jewel-Osco program is assigned a home-base community pharmacy site where approximately 40% of their time is spent. The community sites in bot Chicago and the surrounding suburbs have dedicated teams of experienced preceptors to mentor the resident through the year. Residents also spend time in the Division office in Itasca where leadership and management learning experiences take place.
- Our advanced community-based patient care learning experiences are supplemented with ambulatory care-based patient care in clinics affiliated with each of our college partners: University of Illinois at Chicago, Midwestern University, and Rosalind Franklin University. Through our partnership with these colleges, the residents participate in teaching certificate programs and perform research on campus as well.
